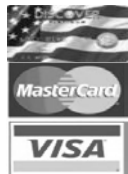

October 2, 2010 come and ride the beautiful roads of the scenic valley between El Paso, Texas and Las Cruces, New Mexico.

There will be routes and distances for everyone – from a 15 mile route perfect for the whole family to 60 miles for those desiring a longer route.

All rides will begin and end at the West Valley Fire Department, 510 E. Vinton Rd., Vinton, Texas conveniently located right off of I-10 at the Vinton exit.

CPSC, ANSI SNELL or ATSM approved helmets must be worn at all times. Roads will be open to traffic. All riders must obey all traffic laws while on the route. Rest stops will be stationed along the routes.

Routes:

- 15 mile – A short ride across the Rio Grande River and returning to the start.
- 30 mile – Ride the back roads of the valley, turning around at Hwy 28/Hwy 227
- 60 mile – Continue on towards Mesilla, New Mexico returning via Hwy 28

All routes are relatively flat, as they follow the valley into New Mexico and back. There is a short climb back up to the starting point.
